

Rules of Conduct

Etiquette: It is universal nudist etiquette in both the gay and straight worlds to bring a towel to sit on for hygienic reasons. We ask that you do so. Rude or obnoxious behavior will not be tolerated. Please remember that we are guests in our hosts' home and to be respectful of their property.

Smoking: Please smoke only in area(s) the hosts have designated as smoking area(s)

Alcohol: Most PSSST functions are BYOB for alcoholic beverages. Exceptions may occur if a host chooses to offer a bar or objects to alcohol in his home. Drunken or obnoxious behavior is not tolerated and may result in loss of membership.

Drugs: Recreational (including 'poppers') or illegal drug use of any kind is not allowed at PSSST events and may result in loss of membership.

Sex: Guidelines regarding sexual activity at PSSST events fall into one of two categories, which are always identified in the NudesLetter. Please observe safe sex guidelines at all times.

- A) At a strictly social event, no overt sexual behavior is allowed. Overt sexual behavior does not forbid hugs or mild showing of mutual affection. Spontaneous erections are considered natural and by most members beautiful things and should not be considered overt or offensive. Aggressive or predatory behavior however will not be tolerated.
- B) An event with a play area, offers a separate area removed from the main party venue. where mutual or group sexual play is allowed during the event. Again, predatory or unwanted aggression will not be tolerated. Be respectful and considerate of all members feelings whenever engaging in or declining sexual play.

Guests, Fees: Members are welcome to bring guests to PSSST functions. Indeed, most of our growth is through members introducing their friends to the club. Members are responsible to ensure that their guests abide by the Rules of Conduct at PSSST events. Guests generally pay \$5.00 more than members when there are cover charges. Membership in similar gay nudist or naturist club is honored at the member rate. If you fail to cancel your reservation, you (and your guest) may be charged for the missed event

Arrivals: Party Assistants at the door of PSSST functions will have you and your guest sign in, will direct you to the changing area and identify the play area location if there is one. After disrobing, please return to the check-in area to have your name written on your chest with a magic marker (easily removable with rubbing alcohol). Please remember at PSSST events, clothing is NOT an option, however, exceptions are made for medical reasons or in extremely cold weather situations.

Hosts, Co-Hosts, and Party Assistants: Please remember that the success of our organization is dependent on the participation of our members. All members are asked to either host or co-host one event a year. Since some members are not able to host an event in their homes, this obligation may be met by assisting at an event. Party Assistants are part of a designated team for a particular event to help with event setup, check-in, food serving, and clean up. A Party Assistant Coordinator may contact you after you make a party reservation or you may contact the Coordinator to volunteer, Assisting at events is fun, and is a great way to meet other members.

Photography: Photographs are allowed to be taken at PSSST events unless otherwise noted. As a courtesy, please ask the subject before taking his photo. There is to be absolutely NO PHOTOGRAPHY in the play area.

Privacy: Confidential membership directories are published and distributed at various times of the year to those who are listed in the directory. The directory may NOT be used as a mailing list or shared with anyone not listed in the directory. When discarding, do it in such a manner that other persons cannot gain access to the information it contains.
